INTRODUCTION Ever try to change a person but couldn't? Ever feel as though your service isn't doing anything for the kingdom?

This msg. same day as 3rd msg

MAIN IDEA: Look ahead as you keep serving. Why? Here are three reasons.

I. First, God is going to "shake up" people. (21)

Luke 21:25-27, MEV: 25 "There will be signs in the sun and the moon and the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring; 26 men fainting from fear and expectation of what is coming on the inhabited earth. For the powers of heaven will be shaken. 27 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

- A. people live in fear—of other people, pandemics, asteroid headed toward moon, asteroids striking earth, pollution, overpopulation, underpopulation, greenhouse effect
- B. day will come when the whole world will be in terror... natural disasters, unnatural terrors unleashed
- C. His desire will be twofold
 - 1. wrath & beginning of judgment
 - 2. salvation of those who are willing

Lesson: God will get through to people we cannot get through to.

II. Second, God is going to overthrow nations (22)

Overthrow: overturn, convert, change

Psalm 2:1, MEV: Why do the nations rage, and the peoples plot in vain?

Psalm 2:8, NKJV: Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the end of the earth for Your possession,

Psalm 72:11, NKJV: Yes, all kings shall fall down before Him; all nations shall serve Him.

A. we might feel too small to struggle against evil we see

- 1. it has too much authority
- 2. it has too much power
- B. God will deal with man's kingdoms (& Satan's rule)

John 16:11, MEV: and of judgment, because the ruler of this world stands condemned.

- 1. their throne (**Throne:** place of authority)
- 2. their strength (**Strength:** might, power)...likely their armies (chariots & riders: men & demons)

C. all evil & ungodly authority completely

Lesson: God will rule the nations that we see ruling wrongly.

III. Finally, God will reward His servants (23)

- A. Zerubbabel is an example for us of faithfulness
 - 1. renewal of an OT promise...rule of line of David
 - God had rejected King Jehoiachin (Jer. 22:24)
 - But God raised up Z, J's grandson
 - 2. Z is in lineage of Jesus, from 2 sides...paternal/ Joseph (Matt. 1), maternal/Mary (Luke 3)
 - 3. God rewards Z for his faithfulness

Signet Ring: a signature ring; given as a pledge, a promise

- B. God will reward all of His faithful servants
 - 1. like Z we are all chosen
 - 2. we show faithfulness by serving Jesus

Lesson: We will be rewarded for our faithfulness.
