INTRODUCTION

MAIN IDEA: Draw nearer to God in steps. How? Here are two steps to take.

- I. First, establish the discipline of tithing (Matthew 23:23)
 - A. in the beginning raises a crisis of faith
 - 1. Do I trust God to keep His word? (Matthew 6:33)
 - 2. Am I serving mammon?
 - 3. Do I understand it's all His?
 - B. becomes accepted part of life with Jesus
 - 1. not enough by itself...no reason for pride
 - 2. ongoing relationship with & trust in Jesus
 - C. enables us to help others...can lead to generous giving
 - 1. support pastors

1Cor 8:14, MEV: In the same way, the Lord has ordained that those who preach the gospel should live from the gospel

2. support the poor... 2% goes to benevolence

Matt. 19:21, Luke 12:33, Luke 14:12-14, Luke 18:22

- 3. help others
- Love offerings Faith Promises to missions 2% to missions

2Corinthians 8:2-3, NLT: 2 They are being tested by many troubles, and they are very poor. But they are also filled with abundant joy, which has overflowed in rich generosity. **3** For I can testify that they gave not only what they could afford, but far more. And they did it of their own free will. [Convoy of Hope]

ILLUSTRATION: good stewardship; budget forms

II. Second, act in agreement with the Holy Spirit

Weightier: of great seriousness & importance

- A. doing the disciplines is good, but not enough
- B. must live out relationship with Jesus—Holy Spirit in us
 - 1. move past ourselves, our world, comfort, troubles
 - 2. reach out with Jesus' love in practical ways

NOTE: Think agape love. Think of Jesus' new commandment: Love one another as He has loved us. (John 13:34, Romans 5:8)

- ▼ Justice: what is right & just according to Jesus; to maintain what is right or to set things right; refers to brotherliness in spirit and action Hayford Bible Handbook
 - **†** Go out of our way to intervene when we see injustice; walk with someone through difficult times.

EX: Dale on bus; John R. on floor;

- ▼ Mercy: compassionate, sympathetic, kind; moves from feeling to action; [a loyal covenant love, extended to others because it has been experienced in one's own relationship with God –*SFLB*]
 - + Help someone in need...car ride, help with lawn, trash; listen

EX:

Matthew 9:12-13, MEV: 12 But when Jesus heard that, He said to them, "Those who are well do not need a physician, but those who are sick. But go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

- ▼ Faith: moral conviction; good faith, honesty, integrity, trustworthiness
 - **†** Be a good neighbor, someone trustworthy...pick up their spilled recycling; let them know about things that might affect them...coming storm, brush pick-up day. Mow their lawn when their mower dies.
