6/29/25 "For Hearing God," Ezekiel 2:1-10, MEV

INTRODUCTION Who really wants to hear from God? us: youth group; later all night to hear; Moses 40 days on mountain

Personal prophecy...

MAIN IDEA: God gives us more of His Spirit to help us better hear Him. Why? For these three reasons.

I. First, for His call on us (1-3)

A. He lifts us up

- 1. from worship
- 2. from our fleshly place
- B. He enables us to hear God more intimately

1Corinthians 2:11, MEV: For what man knows the things of a man, except the spirit of a man which is in him? Likewise, no one knows the things of God, except the Spirit of God.

- C. He helps us understand God's call on us
 - 1. God's purpose for us, work He has for us to do
 - 2. He gives it to us personally...in our spirit; may be confirmed by others, never placed on by others

ILLUSTRATION: sensed call before but after bofHS, then Aurora

II. Second, for His mission for us (4-7)

- A. helping us understand our mission field (3-4)
 - 1. rebellious...to be obstinate, to disobey (Complete Word Study OT)
 - 2. willingly sinning in stubborn refusal to obey

Transgressed: to break away (Strong's), sin in revolt

- 3. impudent...hard of heart (4)
- 4. obstinate... *stubborn (including a sense of violence) in the heart* (4)
- B. strengthening us for the work...greater than we are (1)
 - 1. greater than our ability to accomplish

2. intimidating because of how many, how strong the opposition, how long it will take

Jude 1:20, MEV: But you, beloved, build yourselves up in your most holy faith. Pray in the Holy Spirit. [*see also 1Cor. 14:4*]

C. emboldening us...in the face of hostility, attacks (6)

1. increasing our faith dramatically—our *trust in God*

2. lessening our fear of other people

3. giving us greater confidence in His message/gospel

ILLUSTRATION:

TRANSITION: We might become corrupted by those to whom we minister. (8)

1Corinthians 15:33, NIV: Bad company corrupts good character.

III. Third, for our obedience to Him (8-10)

A. to digest His word (8)

John 14:26, MEV: But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in May name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you.

1. teaching us, helping us understand & apply Bible

2. reminding us of His word

B. to deepen our fear of the Lord (10)

1. greater understanding of His word increases our fear & awe, sense of His holiness

2. protects us...motivates us to obey Him
