8/31/25 "God Loves, Even in Discipline," Deut. 1:41-2:7, NLT

INTRODUCTION Disciplined as a child? Still fed, clothed, loved? *Suffering can have many causes*...

<u>Context</u>: Didn't trust God, so would die in wilderness. Tried without Him to correct mistake but suffered. Edomites (Esau was Jacob/Israel's brother).

MAIN IDEA: Walk with God through hardship. Why? Here are 3 reasons.

I. First, we suffer when we walk apart from Him (1:42-44)

- A. our distrust of Him harms us
 - 1. immediately...we reject His offered help
 - 2. ongoing...as we try to live without Him
- B. the world has dangers too much for us (44)
 - 1. by ourselves, we have limited strength, endurance
 - 2. enemy of our souls is more powerful than we are...lies to, discourages,, torments us—came to steal, kill, destroy (John 10:10)
- C. trying to avoid discipline hurts us further...lying

ILLUSTRATION:

II. Second, we are surrounded by people He cares about (2:4-6)

- A. they have relationship with God (Joshua 24:4, John 3:16)... He created & cares about them; provides for them (Matt. 5:45)
- B. hurt people hurt people...would have been easy for Israelites to take out frustration on Edomites
 - 1. natural reaction might be to lash out
 - 2. tend to think about own hurts, not other people
 - 3. can be condescending as His children
- C. others might not treat us well
 - 1. might feel threatened by us

- 2. might not trust us
- D. He instructs us in relating to them
 - 1. not to bother them (2:5)...by poking finger in eye; difference between witnessing in love & harshness

Bother: stir up, provoke, anger

Mark 14:31, NLT: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

Romans 12:18, NLT: Do you all that you can to live in peace with everyone.

- 2. not try to take what is theirs (2:5)
- 3. pay them for what we need (2:6)...what they deserve; not trying get things for free

III. Third, He will take care of us (2:7)

A. Bless us in all we do...in relationship with Him

Bless: prosper (*Brown-Driver-Briggs*)

- B. Watch over us all of the time...knowing us intimately
- C. Be with us
- D. meet all of our needs (lack nothing/word, deed, thing)

Matthew 6:31-33, NLT: "So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' 32 These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. 33 Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.
