Sermon Series: When God Enters

12/28/25 "A Separating," Matthew 2:1-16, MEV

INTRODUCTION Ever wonder why it is so hard for people to accept Jesus as Lord & Savior? He's so loving, kind, forgiving...

MAIN IDEA: Jesus divides people. Why? Because of the way they respond to Him. Here are five responses represented here.

I. First, some seek Him to worship Him (wise men, 1-2)

Wise men (magi): magician, astrologer; not a follower of Yahweh

A. motivated by an act of God (we have seen His star)

John 6:44, MEV: No one can come to Me unless the Father who has sent Me draws him.

- 1. willing to invest time, resources, ask for help
- 2. sometimes disrupting others (3)
- B. believing what God has said: "Where is the king of the Jews born?" (not if)

Numbers 24:17, MEV: I will see him, but not now; I will behold him, but not near; a star will come out of Jacob, and a scepter will rise out of Israel [Balaam's prophecy]

- C. seeking His Presence
 - 1. rejoice in Him when they find Him
 - 2. humble themselves before Him...bow before Him
 - 3. Sacrifice for Him (gold, frankincense, myrrh)

II. Second, some are fearful because of Him (3)

Trouble: to strike one's spirit with fear, dread (*Thayer*)

- A. troubled by news about Him... "What does it mean?" "How will this affect me?"...spouses
- B. don't seek Him
- C. might be affected by those who are hostile to Jesus

III. Third, some are indifferent to Him (4-6)

- A. might know about Him but don't know Him
- B. might be able give information about Him to others
- C. will not seek Him themselves
- D. might later become hostile to Him or follow Him

IV. Fourth, some are antagonistic toward Him (16-18)

NOTE: Herod the Great...builder, murderer—3 sons, wife, others

- A. self-seeking
- B. view Jesus as a threat to them...their power, their position
- C. deceptive
- D. willing to use others
- E. willing to persecute any to stop Him

NOTE: God doesn't protect everyone. Children killed. Jesus protected because Joseph & Mary obeyed God's warning.

V. Finally, some have intimacy with Him (11, 13-15)

- A. first, answer His call
- B. second, serve Him in any way possible
- C. finally, have intimacy with Him & continue to serve Him
 - 1. He speaks with them
 - 2. He leads them
