1/15/23 "Harpoon Talking," Colossians 4:2-6, MEV INTRODUCTION:

MAIN IDEA: Live so people can find Jesus. How? Here are three things to do.

I. First, pray (2-4)

A. steadily (2)

Continue: with perseverance, steadily (keep praying right along)

- being watchful: spiritually alert for what God's doing, the enemy (distractions), opportunities
- 2. based on our love & thankfulness for Jesus

TRUTH: Praying daily in a quiet time, not just arrow prayers.

- B. for opportunities (open doors) to witness (3-4)
 - 1. God-ordained, provided
 - awareness of: a compulsion, an inner voice, an obvious spiritual conversation
- C. for clarity in speaking of Christ (4)

Clearly: to make known, visible, apparent, to reveal

- 1. not fancy
- 2. from the heart
- 3. what we've witnessed, experienced
- 4. using the scripture we know

ILLUSTRATION:

II. Second, be wise in our conduct (5)

Walk: our conduct in daily life (Wiersbe)
Wisdom: sound judgment, good sense

A. how we act affects how people respond to us

- 1. people react to how we act
- 2. people "size us up" by our behavior (affects their

willingness to converse)

EX: When a person slams things around or is rude to another, do we stand beside them in line or choose another line?

- B. we want to make the most of every opportunity
 - 1. be Jesus: to exemplify love, kindness
 - not be a hindrance to Jesus: repulsive Christian or repulsive person

III. Finally, speak thoughtfully (6)

- A. with grace (undeserved mercy)... kindness, gentleness, respect
- B. with salt (attractively, NLT)

Colossians 4:6, NLT: Let your conversation be gracious and attractive so that you will have the right response for everyone.

- 1. right for the occasion
- pure
- 3. causing thirst for Jesus

C. with intentionality

- 1. to each person appropriately
- 2. to direct each toward Jesus (sow, water, reap)
