4/30/23 "Laziness & Our Future," Hebrews 5:9, 11-6:12, NLT

INTRODUCTION: See Christians who don't care whether they go to church, or who live contrary to Jesus and don't seem to care?

Recipients not new Christians, expected to be mature.

3 kinds of people: unbelievers (rely on human reasoning & emotions), believers fully committed to Him, believers living in sin (not growing in relationship with God)

MAIN IDEA: Keep growing as a Christian. How? Here are three things to do.

I. First, evaluate ourselves (5:11-6:1-2)

2Cor 13:5, NLT: Examine yourselves to see if your faith is genuine. Test yourselves.

A. are we spiritually dull?

Dull: implies a laziness, hinders our ability to perceive or understand spiritual truths

- 1. not picking things up, unable to "hear"
- not mastering basics (repentance from evil deeds or dead works, placing faith in God, baptisms, laying on of hands, resurrection of dead, eternal judgment)
- 3. not able to teach others
- not able to recognize right from wrong (EX: cohabitation, sex outside marriage, mocking, ridiculing, condemning)

B. are we growing? (1-1, LGs, studying Bible daily, serving, growing in humility...Jody Detrick: can always go lower)

**ILLUSTRATION**: trap of the social gospel

II. Second, listen to the warning (6:4-7)

A. repentance necessary for salvation (Heb. 6:1, Matt. 4:17, Luke 15:7, Acts 2:38, et al)

- 1. repent = turn away from sin to God; part of salvation
- 2. even a believer sins & repents

## B. some believers go too far to be able to repent

- having been enlightened (MEV), shared in Holy Spirit, tasted good word of God & power of the age to come
- 2. but turn away from God, reject Jesus (fall away)

Turn away: make defection from, to fall aside, to slip aside, to deviate from the right path, to wander

NOTE: Apostasy means to turn away

Theological apostasy: reject Bible's teachings (esp. about Jesus)

Moral apostasy: willingly break away from a personal relationship with Jesus & become enslaved again to sin

(Fire Bible) Steps leading to apostasy: 1) Believer becomes spiritually unconcerned, resistant, or rebellious; 2) Desires of world become greater than desire to follow Jesus; 3) Increasingly tolerant of own sin; 4) Hardened Heart; 5) Holy Spirit grieved, departs.

III. Finally, embrace our hope (9-12)

A. we are meant for better things that come with salvation

EX: new creature, fruit, transformed mind, children of God, eternity

B. God is just and remembers

- 1. our work hard for Him
- 2. our love for Him shown by our caring for other believers

C. we can make certain our hope—that we will be in paradise

- 1. by continuing to love others as long as we live
- 2. by following the example of others having faith & endurance
- 3. by growing & not becoming spiritually dull, indifferent

NOTE: If you fear falling away, you haven't committed unpardonable sin.
