INTRODUCTION: How many have heard people express worry over receiving the mark of the beast?

pause between 7 trumpets & 7 bowls continues, description of events & persons in Great Tribulation

Gen. 3: Sin entered & God responded (prophecy re: Jesus)

"The devil wrestles with God, and the field of battle is the human heart." -Dostoyevski

MAIN IDEA: We must conquer our personal sin with Jesus' help. Why? Let's take a look at the Great Tribulation to learn what we can.

I. First, God gives Satan authority over earth for a short time

- A. to wage war for 3 1/2 years (5)
- B. to war against the saints & to overcome them (7)
- C. over every tribe, tongue, and nation (7)
- D. Why? Me: Allowing sin to be really sinful so that His justice will be obvious to all.

NOTE: The devil has limited authority over earth now.

II. Second, the devil wants to "be" God

A. will create an "evil" trinity:

- 1. he is "aod" (4)
- 2. beast from sea (antichrist) is his "messiah" (3)
- 3. the beast from the land is his prophet (12)
- B. to be worshiped (4, 12) by all not in Lamb's book of life
- C. to deceive... with signs (13-15)
- D. to execute judgment
 - 1. killing any who do not worship him (15)
 - 2. sealing souls for eternity (16-17)

NOTE: While the devil will have authority to kill God's people, he cannot harm them eternally, nor deceive them.

III. Finally, God will empower His children

A. by salvation (name written in the Lamb's Book of Life)

NOTE: Surrendered to Jesus (Rom. 10:9, Matt. 16:24-25); loving Him & obeying Him (John 14:23)

- 1. we worship Him and will worship no others
- 2. our eternity is secure, and we trust Him for it
- B. to hear God's Spirit (9, 2:7, Matt. 11:15)
 - 1. & recognize God's sovereign hand (Rev. 13:9-10)
 - 2. through living in the Spirit (Gal. 5:16, 25)
- C. to have patience & faith (10)
 - 1. patience...ability to be long-suffering (more grace)
 - faith...trusting God (having confidence in), His promises, His goodness, His love
 - 3. so we trust Him in the worst of times
- D. to have God's wisdom (18)

mark of the beast

- restricting commerce based on receiving the mark
- on right hand or forehead a mark or a name or a number (666)
 - 1. they will recognize the mark of the beast
 - 2. they will not receive it
 - 3. they will love God more than life itself
 - 4. no one knows what it will be

Application Points:

- 1. personal sin makes us vulnerable to the devil & his deceits
- 2. faithfulness to Jesus protects our eternity
- 3. faithfulness to Jesus will draw the devil's attacks
- 4. faithfulness to Jesus secures God's empowerment
