7/30/23 "Overcome," Rev. 1-3, MEV (will read ch. 1)

INTRODUCTION: overcoat with hole in pocket

What must soon take place; blessed if read & obey; time is near; 7 blessings in Rev.; practical, moral instructions; call to action

7 golden candlesticks = churches (respresenting all); 7 stars = angel/pastor of each

2-edged sword = Word of God (grace & forgiveness or judgment)

Summary: 2 churches commended, 5 warned, all exhorted

MAIN IDEA: Live right with God. How? Here are 3 things to do.

I. First, remember that God knows all about us (2:2)

I know your works; Know: to see; the absolute knowledge of God

Works: what a man is and how he acts (Zodhiates)

A. He sees our good & commends us

Labor, patience, testing leaders, endurance, bearing with tribulation, faithfulness to Jesus' name, love, service, faith

B. He sees our evil & will not overlook it

Lack of love (Ephesus), permitting & following false teaching/idolatry/sexual immorality (Pergamum & Thyatira), living for applause of people (Sardis), lukewarmness (Laodicea)

- 1. we justify selves, excuse, compare with others
- 2. He judges by holiness, justifies by Jesus' blood (our repentance)

NOTE: Deceiver wants us to believe we can hide sin or justify it.

Lesson: Our good does not compensate for our sin.

II. Second, heed God's warnings (2:4)

I have this against you Against: down on, intense opposition to

- Because Jesus saves us but we turn away from Him
- Because the Holy Spirit helps us but we ignore Him
- Because we are made clean but return to filth
- · Because He offers Himself but we prefer our sin

 - B. He will come against us if we will not repent

Remove candlestick (Eph.), war against (Pergamum), come like a thief to/blot name out of Book of Life (Sardis), spit out (Laodicea)

III. Third, overcome to be with Jesus

To him who overcomes/He who overcomes.... Hear what the Spirit says to the churches... God encourages all 7 to overcome

Overcome: subdue, conquer, get the victory, prevail

Hear: to obey

- A. by paying attention to what the Spirit says to the churches
- B. by rejecting our own personal sins, societal pressures, false teaching/prophecy
- C. by holding firm in obedience
- D. by repenting when we fall
- E. by continuing in faith in Jesus through it all

ILLUSTRATION:

Overarching lessons...

- Even those who do well must overcome, remain faithful
- Good works never outweigh sin.
- Obeying God gives us victory.

CONCLUSION:

Rev. 3:19-22, MEV: 19 Those whom I love, I rebuke and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent. 20 Listen! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in and dine with him, and he with Me. 21 To him who overcomes will I grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. 22 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. (to Laodicea)
