- 1. we need to avoid temptation to focus on "gaps"
- 2. we need to beware of those who say they know
- D. enemy will introduce fear, insecurity, anxiety
 - 1. fear of unknown, not having control
 - 2. our response: trust in God

APPLICATION: 1) Do what He has told us to do

2) Trust Him: pray, praise, thank

ILLUSTRATION:

II. Second, ready ourselves for the rough road (5-7)

Mystery: something hidden; about final days, Jesus' second coming & establishment of His kingdom (see Romans 16:25)

- A. God has been long-suffering for 6,000 years
- B. time will come when He will act with no more delay
 - 1. an impending sense of something coming (signs)
 - 2. a successive series of terrifying events
 - 3. no escape or relief
- C. What He said to His prophets will occur
 - 1. Jesus will return & set things right
 - 2. He will judge every soul: Heaven or hell
- D. Today is the day of salvation (**2Cor. 6:2NLT:** Indeed the "right time" is now. Today is the day of salvation.)

APPLICATION: 1) Be sure we're right with God

2) Pray for Jesus' return (Rev. 22:20)

ILLUSTRATION:

III. Finally, be faithful to God's message (8-11)

Prophesy: speak under divine inspiration (God's truth, sometimes future telling)

- A. He chooses His messenger & gives messenger message
- B. messenger must fully digest God's message
 - 1. blessing tastes sweet...for those who receive
 - 2. curse tastes bitter...for those who reject
- C. messenger must proclaim message
- D. may not be what we want to hear or say
 - we may want to know more or something different; God says what's important to know
 - 2. we may want to proclaim harsh msg or loving msg, but God gives truth that is both love & judgment

APPLICATION: 1) Obediently respond to His message

2) Humbly share what He gives us
